## WE'RE EXPANDING OUR NGL CAPABILITIES

### Integrating our businesses through the Saturn and Resthaven Projects

In keeping with our strategy to grow in ways that complement and integrate with our existing operations, Pembina announced plans to construct, own and operate two enhanced natural gas liquids ("NGL") extraction facilities. Both located in west central Alberta – an area known for its prolific liquids rich natural gas supply – the Saturn Facility (located in the Berland area) and the Resthaven Facility (located in the Deep Basin) will also include NGL and gas gathering pipelines and, subject to regulatory and environmental approvals, are expected to be in service in late 2013.

The Saturn Facility will connect to Talisman Energy Inc.'s Wild River and Bigstone gas plants through existing and newly constructed gas gathering lines. Once operational, Pembina expects the Saturn Facility will be

able to extract up to 13,500 barrels per day ("bpd") of liquids. We also plan to construct an 83 kilometre ("km"), 8 inch NGL pipeline to transport the extracted NGL to Pembina's Peace Pipeline, which delivers product into Edmonton, Alberta.

"The Saturn Facility is an exciting gas services and infrastructure project," said Bob Michaleski, Pembina's President and Chief Executive Officer. "The strategic location and interconnected nature of the NGL facility enhance our ability to move products in and out of storage and to ship products to markets to meet demand and the needs of our customers."

For the Resthaven Facility, Pembina will modify and expand an existing gas plant. Once fully operational, this facility will include a combined shallow cut and deep cut NGL extraction facility

that is expected to have a gross capacity of 300 million cubic feet per day ("mmcf/d") and 18,000 bpd of liquids extraction capability. In addition, Pembina plans to construct a 44 km, 6 inch diameter pipeline to transport the extracted NGL from the Resthaven Facility on to Pembina's Peace Pipeline. Pembina will own approximately 65 percent of the Resthaven Facility and 100 percent of the NGL pipeline.

"The Resthaven Facility represents another important step in continuing to build out our gas services business," said Mick Dilger, Chief Operating Officer. "By further integrating our conventional pipelines and midstream and marketing services, this project will generate additional value for our stakeholders and help us meet the needs of customers in the area."
